## **History of Ant War**

## **Introduction: Sim Zergling**

Before Ant War was even conceived of as an idea, before I (MDoulos) even joined the Starcraft 2 Arcade as a developer, a developer named Vanished laid the foundation for what would become Ant Colonies and then Ant War.

Vanished published Sim Zergling in 2015 and it did not enjoy much fanfare due to it's complicated options, severe lag, and unresolved bugs. Despite its lack of success, Sim Zergling laid the foundation for later games with concepts such as: a map made out of dirt units that needed to be dug through, a queen that needed to be protected or else the player would lose, a map layout that is almost identical to "Standard" in Ant Colonies and "Basin" in Ant War, zerglings used as the primary fighting force, and specialist units including roaches and ultralisks.

Another developer named Kenoli played Sim Zergling after it launched in 2015. Kenoli took note of the problems he saw with Sim Zergling and seeing more potential for the game type, published an iteration of the game that was more elegant and relatively bug free, called Ant Colonies. Ant Colonies was first published in September of 2016 and went through a handful of iterations. In May of 2017, right before ending further development of Ant Colonies, Kenoli released a developer (dev) map of Ant Colonies so that other people could learn how to use the Starcraft 2 Galaxy editor and potentially make and publish their own iterations and ideas for ant maps if they'd like.


Kenoli made his map open source fairly quickly, even before he released the dev map, he allowed other players to have a copy such as a player named Moon who created an Ant Colonies modification (mod) called Ant Colonies – The Evolution. Unfortunately The Evolution did not differ much from Ant Colonies, was buggy and unbalanced, and the project was abandoned without leaving beta.

Among others who would go on to develop small mods of Ant Colonies, two developers in particular started working on their own versions of Ant Colonies. Metrick used the dev map to make Metrick's Ant Colonies which featured different environmental elements such as hostile insects and weather events. Galsss (aka TheElephant) used the dev map to make Ant Colonies Ant Nob after his clan name Ant Nob, a play on the word Newb. Ant Colonies Ant Nob was primarily a graphical update to structures and units featuring real ant models instead of zerg drones and zerg zerglings. It also featured new map choices and team options.

#### Learning to Develop Ant War

Meanwhile, over the winter of 2017 and 2018, I played a lot of Ant Colonies and acquired a decent skill level by watching replays everytime I lost, in order to learn from the winner's actions. In February of 2018, I was recruited by the Ant Nob clan and started playing Ant Colonies Ant Nob. On February 21st I began helping the developer Galsss design fun ant themed button art after I volunteered my Photoshop abilities. A few days later, after I showed interest in exploring the Starcraft 2 galaxy editor, I was given a copy of the Ant Colonies open-source dev map by Galsss to play around with.

Starting on February 24th of 2018, I began asking questions in the Ant Colonies and Ant Nob discord servers and received answers to extremely basic editor questions as I took my first steps into the overwhelming world of the galaxy editor. Developers such as Kenoli himself, Metrick, and Galsss were quick to send to the different questions. Land about the day may and how to do the different things.



## **How to Play**

Ant War is a very simple strategy game that has only one goal. That goal is to create a large army using the income you obtain from a multitude of workers in order to kill all enemy ant queens while simultaneously protecting your own.

#### Goal

#### **How to Install Ant War**



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
